Another NEW IDEA from COATS & CLARK



J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A. 64: For Single Size (72" x 105")—49 balls of No. 1 White, 22 balls of No. 18-A Shaded Purples, 26 balls of No. 110-A Terrace Green and 3 balls of No. 43 Dk. Yellow.

For Dbl Size (83" x 105")—56 balls of White, 25 balls of Purple, 29 balls of Green and 4 balls of Yellow.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

PANSY MOTIF (make 4) . . . With Yellow ch 5. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 1, in ring make (sc, ch 3) 4 times, pc st and ch 3—to make pc st, make 5 dc in stated place, drop lp off hook, insert hook in first dc of

group, draw dropped lp through, ch 1 to fasten. Join to first sc (5 Yellow lps). Break off and fasten. 2nd rnd: Attach Purple in joining, ch 1, (sc in sc, ch 5) 4 times. Join as before (4 Purple lps). 3rd rnd: Holding Purple lps to back of work and out of way, in next 3 Yellow lps on first rnd make sc, 5 dc and sc (3 small P's); in next 2 Yellow lps make sc, 2 dc, 3 r, 2 dc and sc (2 large P's). Don't join. 4th rnd: Across first small P make sl st in sc, ch 3, 2 dc in 4 dc, 2 sc in dc and sc in sc; across 2nd P make sl st in sc, ch 3, 2 dc in 5 dc, ch 3 and sl st in sc; across 3rd P make sc in sc, 2 sc in dc, 2 dc in 4 dc, ch 3 and sl st in sc; (across next P make sc in sc,

"PANSY PATCH" BEDSPREAD

2 dc in dc, 3 tr in 5 sts, 2 dc in dc and sc in sc) twice. Join, break off and fasten. 5th rnd: With right side facing, attach Green to center of a Purple lp on 2nd rnd; ch 6, 3 dc in lp; in next 3 lps make 4 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc; 3 dc in first lp. Join to 3rd ch of ch-6 (4 sps). Drop Green.

NOTE: On next 2 rnds, always work over strand of unused color to conceal and carry it across section being made. 6th rnd: Leaving a 4-inch end, draw a White lp through lp on hook, ch 2, * in sp with White make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc (shell); dc in dc changing colorsto change colors, complete dc to point where 2 lps remain on hook, drop color, with new color complete dc; with Green make (pc st in dc, dc in dc) twice and pc st in dc, changing color in 5th dc of last pc st; White dc in dc. Repeat from * around. With White, join to top of ch-2. 7th rnd: With White, ch 3, dc in 2 dc; * with White make shell in sp, dc in 3 dc and dc in top of pc st changing color; with Green make pc st in dc, dc in top of pc st and changing color as before, pc st in dc; with White make dc in top of pc st, dc in 3 dc. Repeat from * around, end with White dc in last pc st. Join to top of ch-3. Break off and fasten Green. 8th rnd: Ch 3, dc in 4 dc, * shell in sp, dc in 6 dc, (dc in pc st, de in de) twice; de in 5 de. Repeat from * around. Join, break off and fasten (19 de on each side of Motif).

PANSY PLOCK . . . Leaving chains free, picking up back loops only, sew 19 ac on side of 4 Motifs together, having large pansy petals at outer corners. NOTE: If desired, for greater strength use a strand of Coats & Clark's O.N.T. Nylon Sewing Thread together with Crochet Thread when sewing. Make 124 Bls for Single or 143 Bls for Dbl Size Spread.

PLAIN BLOCK... With White ch 6. Join to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 3, in ring make 4 dc and (ch 3, 5 dc) 3 times; ch 1, h dc in top of ch-3 to form last sp. 2nd to 5th rnds: Ch 3, dc in sp just formed and in top of ch-3 (where h dc was made); * dc in dc to sp; shell in sp. Repeat from * around, end with 2 dc in first sp, form last sp as on first rnd.

NOTE: On each rnd bereafter, repeat from * around and end as on 2nd rnd. 6th rnd: Ch 3, ch in sp, top of ch-3 and 7 de; * de in de, ch 3, skip 1 de, se in de, ch 3, skip 1 de, de in de (lacet over 5 sts); le in 8 de, shell in sp, de in 8 de. 7th rnd: Ch 3, de in sp and top of ch-3; * de in de to lacet; de in de, ch 1, keeping last lps of tr's on hook, tr where last de was made and in next de, thread over,

draw through 3 lps on hook, ch 1, dc where last tr was made (inverted lacet over lacet); dc in dc to sp, shell in sp. 8th rnd: Ch 3, dc in sp, top of ch-3 and 7 dc; * lacet over 5 sts; dc in sp, st and sp; lacet over 5 sts; dc in 8 dc, shell in sp, dc in 8 dc. 9th rnd: Ch 3, dc in sp and top of ch-3; * (dc in dc to lacet; inverted lacet over lacet) twice; dc in dc to sp, shell in sp (corner). 10th rnd: Ch 3, dc in sp and top of ch-3; * dc in each st and sp across side to center 5 dc; lacet over 5 sts; dc in each sp and st across side to corner sp, shell in sp. Break off and fasten (2 sets of 19 dc on each side of Bl). Make 123 Bls for Single or 142 Bls for Dbl Size Spread.

Having a Pansy Bl at the 4 corners, alternating the Bls and leaving chains free, sew 13 x 19 Bls for Single or 15 x 19 Bls for Dbl Size Spread together, matching sts. See Motif

sewing note.

EDGING . . . 1st rnd (right side): Attach White to center of a corner sp, 3 sc in sp, * sc in 19 dc, 3 sc in next 2 sps. Repeat from * around, making 6 sc in next 3 corner sps and, end with 3 sc in first corner sp. Join. 2nd rnd: Ch 7, dc in joining (starting V st); * ch 7, skip 6 sc, sc in 12 sc, ch 7, skip 6 sc, in next sc make dc, ch 3 and dc (V st) Residue. in next sc make dc, ch 3 and dc (V st). Repeat from * around, end with ch 3, tr in 3rd ch of ch-7. 3rd rnd: Ch 1, sc in lp just formed; ** ch 5, in corner V st sp make (dc, ch 3) twice and dc-Dbl V st; * ch 5, sc in lp, ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in 10 sc, ch 5, sc in lp, ch 5, V st in V st sp (V st over V st). Repeat from * across to corner V st sp. Repeat from ** around, end with ch 2, dc in first sc to form last lp. 4th rnd: Ch 1, sc ip 1p, ch 3, sc in lp; ** ch 5, V st in first Dbl-V-st sp, ch 4, V st in 2nd Dbl-V-st sp; * ch 5, sc in lp, ch 3, sc in lp, ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in 8 sc, ch 5, sc in lp, ch 3, sc in lp, ch 5, V st over V st. Repeat from * across to corner Dbl-V-st. Repeat from ** around, end as on 3rd rnd. 5th rnd: Ch 1, sc in lp, ch 5, skip ch-3, sc in lp; ** ch 5, sc in first corner V st, ch 5, Dbl-V-st in sp, ch 5, sc in 2nd corner V st; * ch 5, sc in lp, ch 5, skip ch-3, sc in lp, ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in 3 sc, ch 3, sc in 3 sc, ch 5, sc in lp, ch 5, skip ch-3, sc in lp, ch 5, V st over V st. Repeat from * across to first corner V st. Repeat from ** around, end ch 5. Join to first sc. 6th rnd: Ch 1, sc closely around. Join, break off and fasten.
